Life and career Zheng-Li Dong was born in 1960 in Hong Kong. In 1982, he graduated from the Faculty of Art and Design of the University of Edinburgh, Scotland. After graduation, he went to Beijing, where he earned a master's degree from the Academy of Fine Arts. In 1985 he began to receive commissions from contemporary art galleries in Europe and the United States, and his exhibition at the 2000 Venice Biennale in the Asian Pavilion was the first of his career. He won several awards for his work, such as the Carnegie International Prize in 1991. He currently lives and works in New York City. Work Zheng-Li Dong's work features a high degree of figural realism in ceramic forms. His technique of utilizing unconventional materials is characteristic of his work. In 1993 he made his first use of embossed steel, which has remained a staple in his work ever since. In 2007 he also began using acrylic as a new material for sculpting. Zheng-Li Dong's work has a depth of feeling that comes from his use of human figures. His works are often symbolic and meditative, focusing on the inner life of the subjects. In his series *Life of Dreams* (1996) he used a figure of a young girl who was often seen playing inside her dreams
