This film is a spoof on fairytales, using many common tropes to create an absurdist world. It tells the story of Shrek, who lives with his wife Fiona and her best friend Donkey in peace until the Lord Farquaad shows up and turns their land into a dark-as-night fairy tale kingdom. The Lord has since banished Shrek to much further away than he remembers, but now life is very much different for him. He gets to spend the last of his days with his friend Donkey, talk with his wife, Fiona, and tell her all about the best parts of the fairy tale kingdom he used to live in. However, things seem to change when Farquaad's Princess Fiona comes into Shrek's life bringing the knights of Far Far Away with her. The film was universally disliked by critics and has a 26% on Rotten Tomatoes based on 127 reviews. Roger Ebert gave "Shrek" a negative review, giving it no stars out of four. He stated that the film had "a series of big dumb laughs" but it "contains no originality or wit or skill. It's just loud, stupid noises". Despite the negative reception, the film made over \$650 million at the box office. It was named after a line in "Peter and Gordon" by Peter and Gordon.

The title is a pun on "The Simpsons Movie", which also contains an animated segment spoofing Shrek titled "The Simpsons Movie". Shrek is a featured character in the following video games: In August 2010, it was initially reported that DreamWorks Animation are planning to make a fifth Shrek film for release in 2013, but this was denied by Jeffrey Katzenberg at the quarterly earnings call. However, the sequels are currently in development. The film is rumoured to be about Shrek rescuing Princess Fiona's parents from Lord Farquaad, who has banished them to an unknown place. On March 26, 2013 it was officially announced by Craig Patrick that there were plans for another Shrek movie. It was announced on August 12th 2018 that the fifth installment of Shrek would be released on May 2020. An unofficial Shrek stage show toured the United Kingdom in 2003 and 2004. The show is a revue and includes many of the characters from previous Shrek movies, and also features a very short cameo by Mike Myers. Characters such as Donkey, Puss in Boots, and Lord Farquaad make an appearance in the show. The stage show has Shrek singing to Myrna (a parody of "The Trolley Song" from "Titanic") along with several other pop songs such as "Gimme Some Lovin" while Puss In Boots does his Boogie routine while playing a jazzy piano tune.
