I was wondering if it is possible to "run" makefiles - i.e. say a batch of makefiles as a single build process, instead of having to run make each time. I can't think of any reason why this wouldn't be possible, but I can't find anything about it online. A: Try GNU make-ext-executable If you're using autotools, you might want to look at GNU make-executable, which provides the make-ext-executable functionality. The usage is make-executable where make-executable expects a list of files that need to be compiled into executables. A: I actually just used the -t argument with GNU make, for example:
