Related Collections.Q: How does SqlServer 2008 express/basic's ODBC connect to a database in local system (no ODBC) I've seen several samples using SqlServer 2008 Express which uses an ODBC dll to connect to the database. While I have gone through SQL Server documentation, I cannot figure out how does this works. Below is my understanding of what is required: The SQL Server (2012 version which Express comes with) needs to be installed on the local machine (as ODBC installation needs to be installed) We need to install the ODBC driver (manually or automatically) We need to install the ODBC driver (manually or automatically) Some samples use the dll (sqlodbc.dll) while others use the com object For instance, one of the sample, uses the following code which returns an error "The specified DSN contains an architecture mismatch between the Driver and Application" string connectionString =
