I think I know why it is slow - there are a lot of loops for updating a lot of rows that are in this table. I need to do calculations on each row, so I should not be looping over 200 rows. What is the best way to approach this issue? In your opinion, what is the best way to handle the situation? I can do the calculation in the UI, but I would prefer to do it in the database. I do have an indexed column, but it takes 20+ seconds for the application to start, so I would prefer to speed up the first part of the query, rather than the slower portion. A: My guess is that the indexes are not being used. If you have an index on the column that is being updated, it will be used in the query and the speed of the query will improve. Image caption Michael Leeson, a Scottish solicitor and activist, was murdered by the IRA in 1994 A new edition of the memoirs of a former Northern Ireland and Republic of Ireland security man have been published. The book, titled The Straight Flush: My Life in the Service of Secret Britain, details the work of MI5, MI6 and the SAS.
