NANJING, China (AP) — President Xi Jinping warned mainland China on Thursday to preserve the Communist Party's "one country, two systems" formula that governs Hong Kong's autonomy, and he asserted Beijing's authority over the city-state even though sovereignty is an issue that could drag on indefinitely. His comments followed a deal negotiated in principle on Wednesday by Hong Kong's leader, Carrie Lam, and Beijing's ruling Chinese Communist Party central leaders that pledged to create a new framework for how Hong Kong's relations will work with the mainland. Part of that is a framework for extraditions, but it was seen as a clear rejection of Beijing's chief demand that the new arrangement allow the justice system in Hong Kong to be transferred to mainland authorities. The exchange capped days of frenetic, last-minute negotiations on the pact struck between Hong Kong's chief executive and central leaders. The framework deal contained no specifics and almost no details. It was signed only by Lam and Zhang Dejiang, head of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress, the rubber-stamp legislature that is controlled by the Communist Party. A communique from the summit of the Communist Party's top decision-making bodies said the issues of Hong Kong's autonomy and its relations with the mainland "should be properly safeguarded and handled to ensure long-term prosperity and stability of Hong Kong." But the document didn't say how. The phrase was interpreted by many in Hong Kong as a warning to the government not to push for a more independent judiciary in a move that Beijing would see as a breach of the deal. The document also said other issues, such as the number of seats each government department will have in Hong Kong's legislature, should be resolved by the standing committee "in accordance with law." "The 'one country, two systems' formula basically means Hong Kong is a sovereign territory, and the mainland has no right to interfere in its internal affairs," said Junius Ho, a political science professor at the Chinese University of Hong Kong. Story continues "Theoretically, Hong Kong's universal suffrage can be on the agenda, and maybe as early as 2020, if approved by the standing committee," Ho added. "But this article basically means mainland China will ensure Hong Kong's prosperity and stability. That is it." Hong Kong's future has been in jeopardy for decades.
