In July of 2011, Dale Dougherty of the U.S. National Academy of Sciences gave a series of presentations on "Technology and Society," as part of the National Academy's 20th birthday celebration. In one of his presentations, Dougherty explained that he is not convinced that our current understanding of how technology affects us is realistic. "Yes, the Internet has made us smarter, better informed, and more aware of the world. It is really wonderful," said Dougherty. "It is also leading to an understanding that much of what we know is probably wrong. My simple conclusion is that we should rethink the very nature of technology, and how it will affect how we live." Douglas Dowd, Ph.D. Professor in the Department of Biomedical Engineering at the University of Washington has taken this statement a bit further. "For decades I have been trying to explain how the technology around us creates our world and how the world works, and yet I still don't understand it," said Dowd. "The reality is that everyone's understanding of technology today is wrong, because technology is so complex that people simply cannot grasp how it works. So many people believe that what we know about it is true. It isn't." Dowd is a well-known expert on wireless technology. He has written dozens of books and articles about RF, UHF, microwave, cellular, satellite, and RFID technologies, and he has been a speaker at industry conferences and a guest lecturer at universities. It's evident that he is no fan of the way wireless technology is used. "What we used to think we knew, is not true. So why do we still use it?" Dowd asks. "There are so many things about it we don't know, and so many things wrong with it, that we don't realize that they're wrong. The problem with any technology is that for every problem there is a solution, and many of these solutions are so ridiculous that we don't even consider that there is a better solution." Although he is too humble to say it, Dowd likely has the best explanation
