I need to parse this file using SAX parser, but I am not sure how can I parse it. I did some research and found sax is very easy to use. I can parse this file but I do not understand how should I parse lines. I will really appreciate any help. A: The string you're trying to parse is actually XML, not XHTML. The XML you have contains a document declaration. It doesn't look like you found the document root element that's opening the XML document -- that element is in your file. You probably want to start with your file by reading it into a DOMDocument.
